Digital technologies have remarkably changed teenagers' life and work both positively and negatively. According to UNICEF, 71% of 15–24-year-olds are online and one third of Internet users are under 18 years old.

A 3D printer turns a whole object into thousands of tiny little layers, then makes it from the bottom-up in layers of material. There are many applications of these printers. For example, they are used to create medical implants, household items, and fashion accessories.

One of the major advantages of 3D printers is that they make use of different kinds of materials like plastic, metal, or food ingredients. Therefore, by using 3D printers, people can reduce material waste. In addition, they can create complex and customised objects that traditional manufacturing methods cannot produce.
