Modbury, a small town in England, has become famous for being the first place in Europe to ban plastic bags. The idea came from Rebecca Hosking, a filmmaker who showed local shopkeepers how plastic harms sea animals. Today, life in Modbury is very different. If you walk down the street with a plastic bag, people might look at you strangely because **it** is seen as "antisocial behavior". The shops also sell special bags made from recycled cotton or cornstarch, which can break down naturally without hurting the environment.

As one local resident said, "The sooner we get rid of plastic bags, the better". This experiment proves that when people work together, they can protect the planet for the future.
